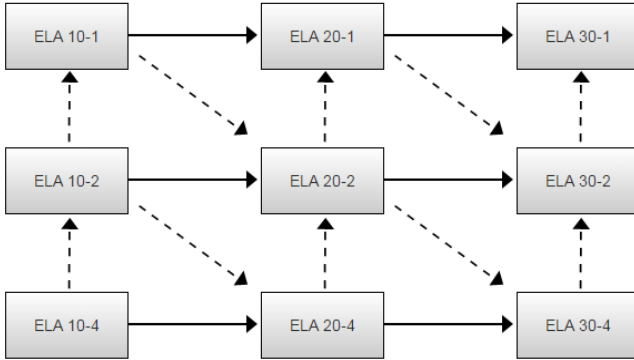

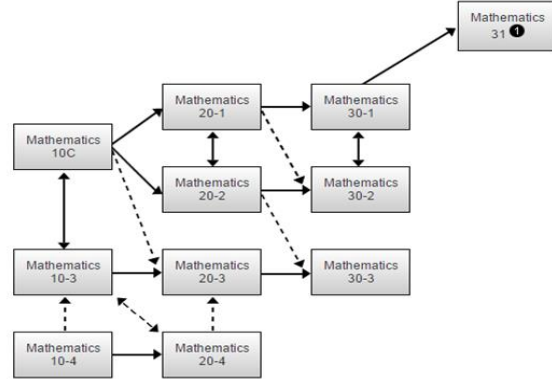

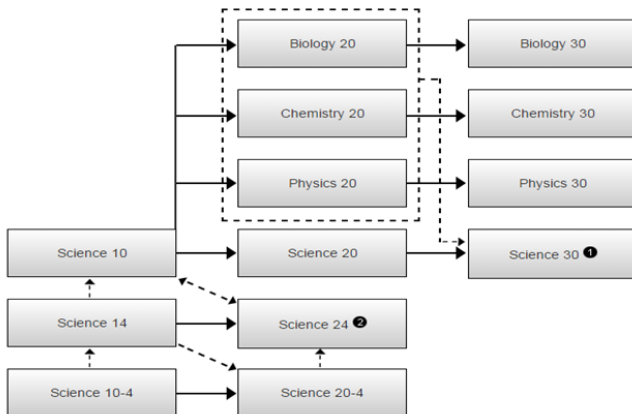


The courses in the sequence chart are worth 5 credits each.

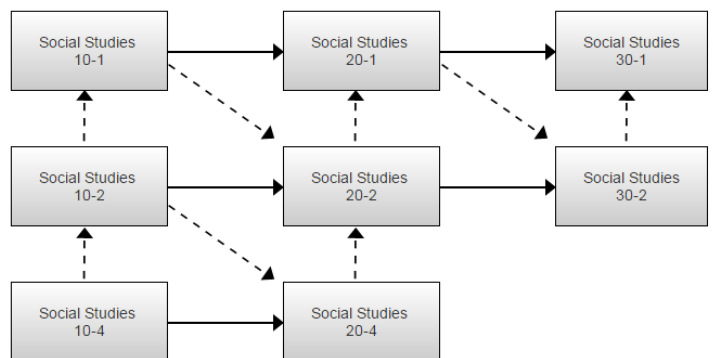
