Graduation Requirements

Alberta High School Diploma

- **15 credits English** (must complete 30-1 or 30-2)
- **15 credits Social Studies** (must complete 30-1 or 30-2)
- **10 credits Mathematics** (must complete 20 level)
- **10 credits Science** (must complete 20 level)
- **3 credits Physical Education 10**
- **3 credits CALM** (Career & Life Management)
- **10 credits Options** (Career & Technology Studies or Fine Arts Second Languages or Physical Education 20 / 30)
- **10 credits Any 30-Level Courses** (other than English or Social)
- **Additional credits to reach a total of 100**

Alberta Certificate of Achievement

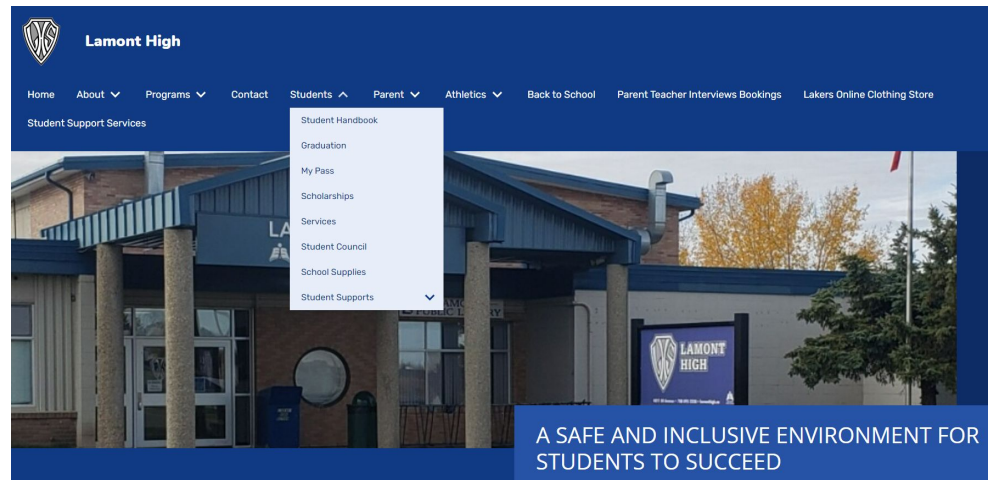
- English Language Arts 20-2 or 30-4
 - Mathematics 10-3 or 20-4
 - Science 14 or 20-4
 - Social Studies 10-2 or 20-4
 - Physical Education 10 (3 credits)
 - Career and Life Management (3 credits)
 - HCS3000 (must be completed before Work Experience - 1 credit)
 - **5 credits in one of the following options:**
 - 30-level Knowledge and Employability Occupational course
 - 30-level Career and Technology Studies (CTS)
 - **5 credits in one of the following options:**
 - 30-level Knowledge and Employability Workplace Practicum Course
 - 30-level Work Experience course (125 hours paid or volunteer work)
 - 30-level Green Certificate course
 - Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) course
 - **Additional credits to reach a total of 80**

Certificate of School Completion

- *Student worked towards goals and objectives in their individualized program plan (IPP) / Instructional Support Plan (ISP)*
 - *By the end of the nomination school year, the student has been a student for at least 12 years (and is 17 years old or older by March 1 of the nomination year).*
 - *The school year in which the nomination is being submitted is the student's last year of school programming*
 - *The student registration in PASI usually includes one of the following special education codes at the time of school completion (41, 43, 44, 52).*

- ❖ Saturday June 8th, 2024 @ ~ 2 PM
 - Lamont High School Gymnasium
 - Free
 - Seats ~400 + Grads on stage
- ❖ Friday May 24, 2024 @ evening
 - DOW Centennial Centre, Fort Saskatchewan
 - Price varies from ~\$1000 to \$1650 depending on length
 - Seats ~538 + Grads on stage
 - Includes 2 technicians (light & sound)

Potential Date & Venue

- ❖ Lamont Hall - Date TBD
 - 1 day (4 - 9 hrs) = \$425 + tax
 - 2 day (4 - 9 hrs) = \$775 + tax
 - Only includes chairs
 - Seats 545, no stage

- ❖ Lamont Arena - Date TBD
 - 1 day = \$750 + tax
 - Seating only
 - Seats 1620 (including sides), no stage
